### Squamish Off-Road Cycling Association Notes to Financial Statements As at December 31, 2022

#### 1. Cash

As at December 31, 2022, the cash balance included \$215,569 (2021 - \$99,000) in grant funds which are restricted in use. \$290,000 (2021 - \$215,000) also included in the December 31, 2022 cash balance has been internally restricted for trail maintenance projects. See Note 2 for further details.

#### 2. Restricted funds

As at December 31, 2022, \$505,569 (2021 - \$314,000) of net assets are restricted in use. Of these restricted funds, \$215,569 (2021 - \$99,000) are externally restricted in use as follows:

The Board also approved to internally restrict \$290,000 (2021 - \$215,000) at the December 5th, 2022 Board meeting towards the following projects: \$125,000 for Brennan Park Skills Park, \$90,000 for expansion of the Diamond Head trailhead and parking lot, \$40,000 for completion of Miki's and Cardrona trails, and \$35,000 for the Cheekeye Debris Barrier.

#### 3. Remuneration

In 2022 SORCA paid \$152,386 in remuneration to employees of the society and persons under contract.
