1. Accounting policies

These financial statements reflect accrual accounting. SORCA has adopted the deferral method for revenue recognition of contributions.

2. Cash and cash equivalents

As at December 31, 2023, the cash balance included \$84,000 (2022 - \$215,569) in grant funds which are restricted in use and recognized as deferred revenue. \$155,000 (2022 - \$290,000) also included in the December 31, 2023 cash balance has been internally restricted for trail maintenance projects. See Note 3 for further details.

3. Deferred revenue & contributions

As at December 31, 2023, deferred revenue & contributions includes \$84,000 of unearned grant funding which is externally restricted in use for specific programs and \$81,840 of deferred membership revenue. The breakdown of externally restricted grant funding is as follows:

4. Restricted funds

As at December 31, 2023, \$155,000 (2022 - \$505,569) of net assets are restricted in use. At the December 5th, 2023 Board meeting, the Board approved to internally restrict \$155,000 (2022 - \$290,000) towards the following projects: \$95,000 for expansion of the Lower Diamond Head parking lot, \$20,000 for completion of Brennan Park Skills Park, \$20,000 for revitalization of the Valleycliffe Skills Park, and \$20,000 for the Squamish Nation Youth Mountain Bike Program related expenses.

5. Remuneration

In 2023 SORCA paid annual remuneration in excess of \$75,000 to two individuals including employees of the society and contractors. Total remuneration paid to these individuals was \$218,223.

6. Trail work contractors

In 2023 SORCA contracted trail work totaling \$243,393, which included the following projects: Cardrona, Miki's Extension, Cliff's Corners, Tracks from Hell, Man Boobs, Pamplemousse, Mashiter Bridge, Brennan Park Skills Park, and Lower Diamond Head parking lot expansion.
